2009 Streetcar Shootout Class Information

All Classes	
Vehicle	Must be titled, plated, insured, and street driven (no race cars)
Fuel	Pump Gas, Race Gas, Ethanol, Auxiliary Injection
Drive Train	Front, rear, and all wheel drive allowed in all classes
Safety	Must follow 2009 NHRA Rulebook - Up to the discretion of the race director
Interior	Removal of carpet and interior pieces allowed, but a street car appearance is encouraged

Normally Aspirated 4/6/Rotary	
Class Designation	NA – Write NA then your tech card number on window (ex: NA – 317)
Engine	4 cylinder, 6 cylinder, and rotary only
Power Adders	No power adders allowed
Tires	Slicks allowed Factory wheel wells must be retained – No wheel tubs
Body	Lightweight body panels allowed, but must remain full street capability No 1-piece front ends or lexan windows
Example Cars	Honda Civic, Integra, & S2000, Mazda RX-7 & RX-8, Nissan 350Z, Scion tC, Nissan 240
Notes	This class is designed for any normally aspirated 4, 6, or rotary street car in front, rear, and all drive configurations.

Power Adder 4	
Class Designation	P4 – Write P4 then your tech card number on window (ex: P4 – 317)
Engine	4 cylinder only
Power Adders	Turbo, Superchargers, and Nitrous allowed Multiple power adders allowed
Tires	Slicks allowed Factory wheel wells must be retained – No wheel tubs
Body	Lightweight body panels allowed, but must remain full street capability No 1-piece front ends or lexan windows
Example Cars	SRT-4, Cobalt SS, Turbo Honda, SR20 240, Mazdaspeed 3, Subaru WRX/STi, Mitsu EVO
Notes	This class is designed for any 4 cylinder street car with power adders in any configuration

Power Adder 6	
Class Designation	P6 – Write P6 then your tech card number on window (ex: P6 – 317)
Engine	6 cylinder and Rotary
Power Adders	Turbo, Superchargers, and Nitrous allowed Multiple power adders allowed
Tires	Slicks allowed Factory wheel wells must be retained – No wheel tubs
Body	Lightweight body panels allowed, but must remain full street capability No 1-piece front ends or lexan windows
Example Cars	Toyota Supra, Mazda RX-7, GTP, Nissan 300ZX, Nissan GT-R, Porsche 911
Notes	This class is designed for any 6 cylinder or rotary street car with power adders in any configuration

Pony Car	
Class Designation	N8 – Write N8 then your tech card number on window (ex: N8 – 317)
Engine	8 cylinder engines
Power Adders	Natural aspiration only No power adders Ford Lightning owners see Example Cars and Notes
Tires	Slicks allowed Factory wheel wells must be retained – No wheel tubs
Body	Lightweight body panels allowed, but must remain full street capability No 1-piece front ends or lexan windows
Example Cars	F-body, Mustang, Corvette, SRT-8 Chrysler, Trail Blazer SS, FWD 8 cyl. Ford Lightning IS allowed so long as the OEM supercharger is used and there is no excessive weight reduction. SRT-10 Dodge pickup truck is allowed. 03-04 Mustang Cobra, Dodge Viper, and LS7 Corvette will need to run P8 or Quick 8 Abnormal engine swap cars such as LS1 RX-7 or LS1 and Terminator swapped Fox Bodies will need to run P8 or Quick 8.
Notes	This class is designed for naturally aspirated Pony Cars such as the Camaro, Trans Am, and Mustang to duke it out for king of the hill, but provisions have been made for cars with similar performance in other configurations such as an OEM blower Lightning, TB SS, and SRT-10 P/U. Lightning guys, if we feel like your truck has extensive modifications, you will have to run a higher class.

Power Adder 8	
Class Designation	P8 – Write P8 then your tech card number on window (ex: P8 – 317)
Engine	8, 10, 12 and more cylinders
Power Adders	Any Multiple power adders allowed
Tires	Slicks allowed Factory wheel wells must be retained – No wheel tubs
Drive Train	Any
Body	Lightweight body panels allowed, but must remain full street capability No 1-piece front ends No lexan windows
Example Cars	03-04 Mustang Cobra, Viper, LS1 RX-7, Corvette Z06 & ZR-1, Any nitrous, turbo, or s/c pony car

Quick 8	
Class Designation	Q8 – Write Q8 then your tech card number on window (ex: Q8 – 317)
Engine	Any
Power Adders	Any - Multiple power adders allowed
Tires	Slicks allowed Wheel tubs allowed
Drive Train	Any
Body	Lightweight body panels allowed, but must remain full street capability - Lexan allowed
Example Cars	Run what you brung as long as it is street legal.
Notes	This class will take the 8 fastest qualifying times of the day in a Quick 8 class to find the quickest street car
